## PAST MEETING

At the February ACRL meeting at Pacific University Dr. Stephen Beckham from Lewis and Clark College discussed ways in which libraries have helped him in his research. He also suggested that academic libraries could do a better job of processing maps and photographs, hoped that librarians would not do too much deaccessioning of materials ("they'll be useful to someone sometime"), and praised libraries which have comfortable and aesthetic (non-plastic) lounge areas with lamps instead of overhead fluorescent lights, etc.

The Academic Status Committee of ACRL would like to request your help in identifying questions relating to academic status which are of substantial interest to librarians. The committee has in the past and would now be willing to address such concerns in a variety of ways. Are you aware of areas in which guidelines, such as those published in College and Research Libraries News in September 1977 on "Guidelines and Procedures for the Screening and Appointments of Academic Librarians," are needed? Or do you share with your colleagues a concern better dealt with through a general research process, conference program or workshop?

Dealing with a subject rich in potential areas of investigation, the committee wishes to assure that its activities are directed towards the principal concerns of the academic librarian and asks for your assistance in defining those concerns not only on the national level but on the local and regional level as well.
