# --MEETING TO EXAMINE OFF-CAMPUS STORAGE

The meeting will focus on the storage of library materials at Camp Adair, but will also include some developments on automation.

  - (3) DICK TUFFLI, Librarian at Clackamas County Library, will describe the automated system used by the Clackamas County Library Network.


## ACRL/OREGON-WASHINGTON ET AT SEABECK IN 1981
