(3) DICK TUFLI, Librarian at Clackamas County Library, will describe the automated system used by the Clackamas County Library Network.

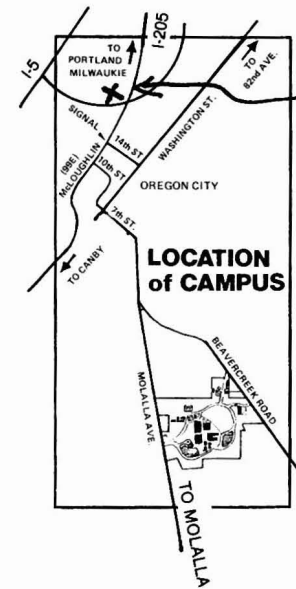
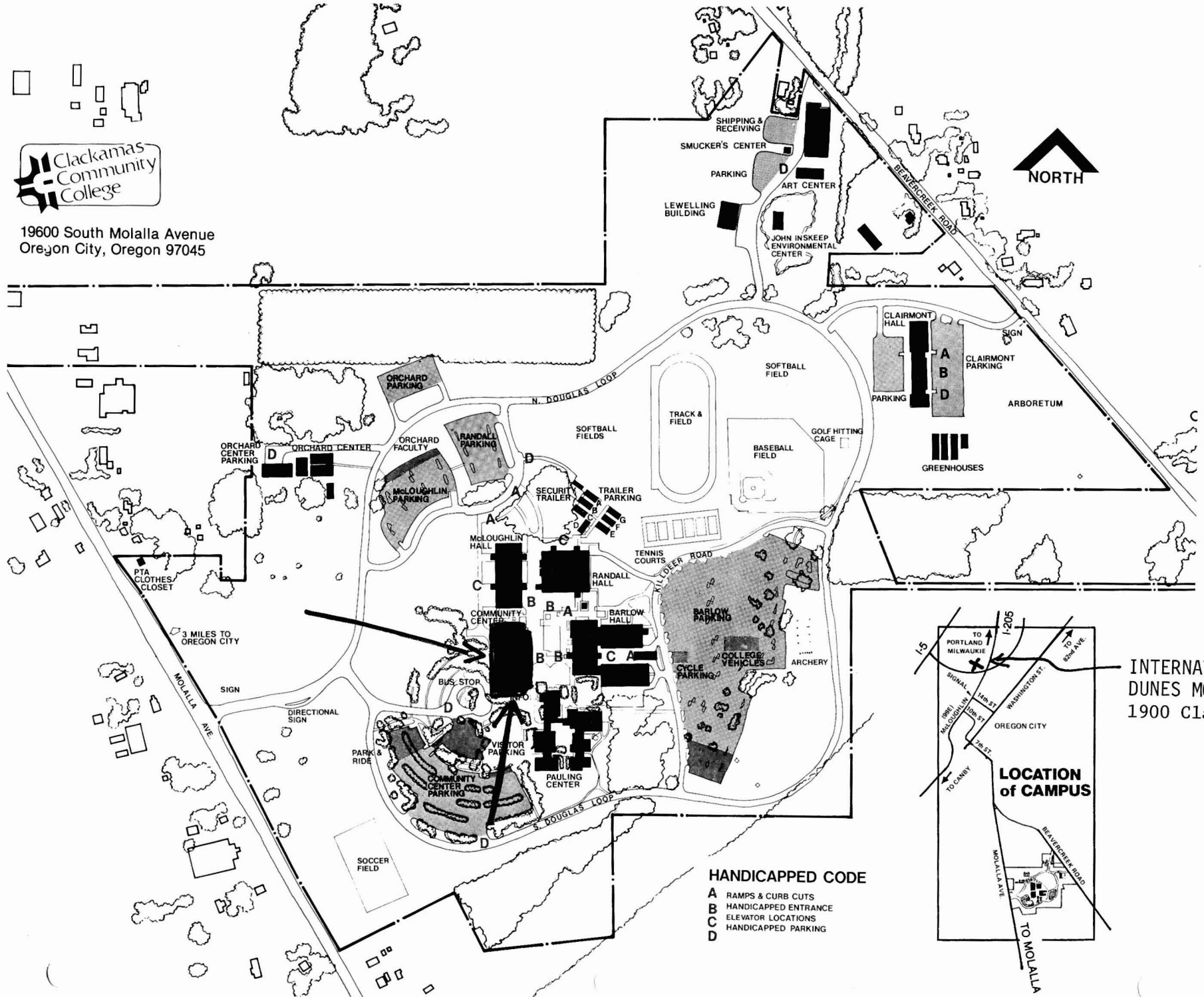


