ACRL/OREGON CHAPTER ANNUAL ELECTIONS

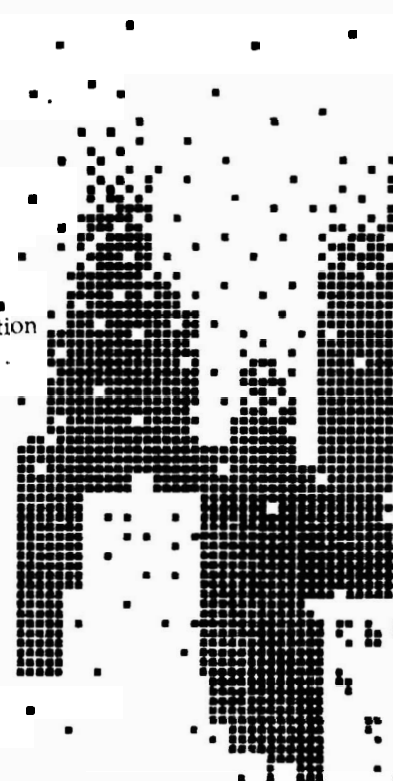
