Portland State University Library is cooperating with the ACRL Oregon Chapter to sponsor a showing of a new series of instructional video tapes on the Ohio College Center System. The program will be held: FEBRUARY 3 (Thurs.), 1977, at 1:30 PM in CRAMER HALL, Room 71, on the campus of PORTLAND STATE UNIVERSITY

After viewing of the tapes, Ms. Myra White, Library Coordinator for the Western Service Center of OCLC, will be hand to answer further questions and discuss the OCLC System.

There are four tapes in the series: 1) Finding information in the OCLC System (Part I) is designed for viewing by library patrons; 2) a continuation of one; 3) The OCLC System - for use of librarians; 4) On Line Cataloging - for use by librarians.
